



## Research Abstracts

The Research Abstracts gallery at The Physiology Course allows early-career researchers to share their work with their colleagues! Abstracts will be reviewed by course directors and winners will be selected to present during the conference. **Submissions open March 3, 2025 and submissions close May 19, 2025 (with NO exceptions).**

### Eligibility:

- Submitters must be students, residents, or fellows
- Submitters may not be Physiology Course faculty, staff or industry representatives
- Submitters may submit a maximum of one (1) abstract
- Winners will be selected no later than Monday, May 26, 2025, and will receive a travel grant to cover expenses for attending the course

### Categories:

- Coronary

### Submission format and process:

- All submissions must be [uploaded here](#).
- Submit via PDF, Word Doc, or PPT using the following naming convention: Last Name\_ Abstract Title (example: Smith \_ Intravascular Imaging for Plaque Characterization)
- On first page/slide, include the following: Abstract Title, Submitter First and Last name, Degree, Affiliation, Contact email address
- Final presentation will be a poster, with 1 winner selected to present a PPT during the program
